Requirements: Students receiving support are expected to participate in House activities, including the Opening Retreat, Talent 4 the house, Wise Practice, House Meals, and other activities supporting the mission and work of Disciples House.

Release: In making this application for support from Disciples Divinity House, you agree to allow access to your application file at Vanderbilt Divinity School to the Dean of Disciples House and its Admissions Committee for the purpose of evaluation.

Policies: Board policy requires that a student receiving support from Disciples Divinity House at Vanderbilt have been a member of a recognized congregation of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) for at least two years. At present, scholarship support is limited to Masters of Divinity students. United Church of Christ students are eligible to apply and may receive scholarship support if funds are available.
